



Free Medical Alert Necklace Offer for People with Diabetes

The Diabetes Research and Wellness Foundation, a non-profit organization, offers free medical alert necklaces to people with diabetes. On the necklace, which is made of a nickel alloy, is written, "I HAVE DIABETES. PLEASE TEST MY BLOOD BEFORE TREATING ME." Medical identification (ID) helps people with diabetes get the care they need during medical emergencies. This is important for people with diabetes whose blood sugars can change quickly. For example, when a person's blood sugar is very low, he/she may be unable to call for help.

Wearing medical ID means medical facts about a person are quickly shared with the health care team. A medical alert ID is also used by people with other conditions as well, such as heart disease, allergies, dementia, asthma, autism, blood disorders or epilepsy. Children with special needs or people on a lot of medications or blood thinners should especially have this type of ID. People with many health problems may choose an ID that lists them all.
